## POLICIES AND PROCEDURES

**NUMBER:** Policy 2.02

**SUBJECT:** College Catalogs and Student Handbooks

### 1. Undergraduate

Academic requirements for graduation (including major and minor requirements, as well as general degree requirements) are those set forth in the *Blue Mountain College Undergraduate Catalog* which is in effect at the time of a student's initial enrollment, with the exception of requirements for students enrolled in a teacher education program. Academic requirements in a teacher education program are those prescribed by the Mississippi Department of Education at the time of a student's graduation. However, a student who is readmitted after having taken no classes at Blue Mountain College for two calendar years may be required to fulfill the graduation requirements set forth in the undergraduate catalog which is in effect at the time of the student's readmission. Students enrolled at Blue Mountain College are subject to all rules and regulations as specified in the *Blue Mountain College Student Handbook*.

### 2. Graduate

Academic requirements for graduation for graduate students are those set forth in the *Blue Mountain College Graduate Catalog* which is in effect at the time of the student's initial enrollment. Graduate students enrolled at Blue Mountain College are subject to all rules and regulations as specified in the *Blue Mountain College Handbook for Graduate Studies*.

### 3. Changes in Catalogs and Handbooks

The college reserves the right to change any of its regulations, charges, rules, and courses without notice and to make such changes applicable henceforth, not only to new students but also to students already registered. The current catalog or handbook is the one posted on the Blue Mountain College Web site.

### 4. Time Limit on Catalog Requirements

Students in continuous enrollment may graduate under the catalog in effect at initial enrollment provided they complete requirements within a six-year period. Students who do not complete requirements for graduation during the six-year period will be expected to meet requirements listed in the current catalog. Any student who withdraws from the College and re-enrolls is subject to the catalog current at the time of re-enrollment. Note exception: Teacher education requirements are dictated by the Mississippi Department of Education (MDE) and are subject to change. Therefore, students must meet MDE requirements in operation at the time of re-enrollment.
