BLACK IS THE STANDARD COLOR FOR ACADEMIC GOWNS. BACHELOR'S AND MASTER'S GOWNS ARE UNTRIMMED. DOCTORAL GOWNS ARE FACED WITH BLACK VELVET OR THE COLOR ASSOCIATED WITH THE DEGREE WITH THREE BARS ACROSS THE SLEEVES.

GOLD CORDS REPRESENT THE ACADEMIC HONORS OF CUM LAUDE, MAGNA CUM LAUDE, AND SUMMA CUM LAUDE. THE GOLD STOLE DENOTES A GRADUATE OF THE HONORS PROGRAM.
