ALUMNI GRANT **\$1,000 PER YEAR; RENEWABLE / STACKABLE**

- Two siblings enrolled concurrently receive \$500 each per semester

The Legacy Award for Outstanding Community College Students

- Blue Mountain College's top Transfer scholarship award recognizes outstanding academic performance, demonstrated leadership, and proven service to others. A separate application process with a submission deadline of May 1st is required of this scholarship. A minimum GPA of 3.25 is required to apply and an interview may be required. This competitive scholarship is awarded for fall semester entry students only. Scholarship recipients will be required to participate in the **Leora Duce Leadership Initiative** and perform leadership services for the College up to 50 hours per semester. Scholarship amounts vary up to full tuition for four semesters and are renewable with a 3.25 GPA. **This award does not stack with other academic awards.**
