SUBJECT: International Study Programs

Blue Mountain Colleges offers, or participates in programs involving study abroad. To assure adherence to Blue Mountain College standards and to minimize conflict and miscommunication, it is important that all such programs be coordinated carefully. This coordination is provided through the Director of International Programs and the International Studies Committee.

No international study should be offered or publicized in the name of Blue Mountain College, and no promise of credit at Blue Mountain College should be made or implied, without the prior approval of the Director of International Programs and the International Studies Committee. Any course offered for credit on or off campus must have the endorsement of the appropriate department chair. Any proposal to offer a program of international study should include pertinent information concerning costs, staffing, compensation, selection of participants and related matters, assessment plans, in addition to full information about academic requirements. Since these programs vary widely, the Director of International Programs will determine when the approval of other persons or offices is needed.
