**SUBJECT:** Continued Association with College

### 1. General

Attending Blue Mountain College is a privilege, not a right. When a student enrolls at Blue Mountain College, she/he becomes an active citizen of the College community. This community is based on the belief in individual honor and the trustworthiness of every student. In conformity with the ideals of Christian living, and in order to maintain and protect its standards of scholarship and character, Blue Mountain College reserves the right to establish an educational partnership with only those students who are willing to abide by the principles of a Christ-centered institution. At a minimum, this will require adherence to the rules and regulations of the College, including protecting and upholding the institution's Honor Code.

### 2. Undergraduate Students

The *Blue Mountain College Student Handbook* identifies the rules and regulations, including the Honor Code, which governs conduct and behavior of Blue Mountain College students.
