SUBJECT: **Tuition Discounts**

Blue Mountain College strives to assist multi-student families by providing a tuition discount of up to 15%. If two or more siblings, spouses and/or parent and child(ren) are enrolled simultaneously as full-time students then a tuition discount of up to 15% may be awarded to each student.

Conditions for Receiving Tuition Discounts

- Each student must have final admission.
- Each student must be simultaneously enrolled full-time.
- Each student must have a complete FAFSA on file with the Office of Financial Aid.
- Eligibility is verified by the FAFSA or other documentations, as needed.
- Students may be classified as undergraduate, graduate or in an online-only program.
- Siblings must be supported by the same household.
- Students with a parent enrolled must be supported by the enrolled parents' household.
- If one student is degree-seeking and another is non-degree seeking, then only the degree-seeking student would receive the discount.
- If one student receives an athletic scholarship and another does not, then only the student(s) that is not awarded the athletic scholarship will receive the discount. *NOTE: Any member of an athletic team must receive written permission from their head coach and the athletic director prior to receiving any tuition discount, due to NAIA regulations.*
- If one student receives another type of benefit for full-tuition and the other does not, then only the student(s) that is not awarded the full-tuition benefit would receive the discount.
