PREVENTION

While Blue Mountain College is taking measures to protect the health and safety of students, faculty, and staff, individuals can take personal measures to prevent the spread of COVID-19 by adhering to the following recommendations:

- Wear a mask in public places.
- Avoid close contact with people who are sick.
- Avoid touching eyes, nose, and mouth.
- [Wash hands](#) often with soap and water for at least 20 seconds.
- If soap and water are not available, use hand sanitizer.

What are the size limitations for events?

50% room capacity (or current state/federal recommended guidelines) while practicing social distancing.

Will physical/social distancing be observed?

Physical/social distancing will be implemented in all college facilities whenever possible.

What is the protocol for entering campus buildings?

Guests must report to the Business Office (located on the first floor of the Lowrey Administration Building) from 9:00 a.m.-4:30 p.m., Monday-Friday. Prospective students and their families will check-in with the Office of Admissions (located on the lower level of the Paschal Student Union Building). Guests staying in one of the residence halls must check-in with the Resident Director between 7:00 p.m.-11:00 p.m.

Will guests have their temperatures checked and complete a written survey?

Guests will have their temperatures checked and answer a series of questions related to COVID-19. The College will keep a written record of guests in case contact tracing is necessary.
